

SHEPEARD BLOOD **HIGH SCHOOL** **HEROES**

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Summary: This program is designed to cultivate the next generation of blood donors. Schools who encourage students, staff, and faculty participation in successful lifesaving blood drives will be awarded grants to help facilitate student achievement.

A. The school must host at least 2 blood drives a year, and all blood drives hosted by the school shall be with Shepeard Community Blood Center.

B. The school will earn \$20 from each donation. Donors who give blood through an automated device will earn \$40 for their school.

C. Shepeard will reimburse the school the cost of one (1) substitute teacher for drives whose goal is more than 30 units. This is to allow the drive chair to help facilitate on the day of the drive rather than having to balance his/her time between the blood drive and the classroom.

D. All grant checks will be distributed from May 1- June 30th. Checks will be made out in the name of the school - not a particular organization, student, club, etc.

E. High School Heroes may not be combined with other Shepeard programs (e.g. replenishment) or special promotions.

F. All grants must directly benefit students in the form of: A) Scholarships to attend accredited higher education entities, technical schools, or certification classes; B) Supplies, tools, or technology used by students or teachers to promote academic achievement; C) Scholarships to attend academic conferences, meetings, competitions, etc. Schools may limit the scope of these areas by developing additional criteria.

G. The school Principal has the final say on funding decisions as long as it adheres to the uses outlined in the Program Guidelines.
